HD, DVR, & ON DEMAND UPGRADES CONTINUE

The work to bring Digital Video Recorder (DVR), On Demand, and a more robust, affordable high definition (HD) service to customers continues.

As we have explained in previous articles, we are in the conversion process to deliver PBTv services using Internet Protocol (IP) technology. Due to the size of our service area (over 4,500 square miles) and the time it takes to convert each location, we cannot provide these services to all locations immediately. Like high speed Internet service and regular PBTv service before, we will have to rollout these advanced services over the course of a few years.

While over 75% of PBTv subscribers can now get access to these advanced television services, it is difficult to state in a general newsletter article who can receive them because their availability is specific to each location. If you are interested in finding out if PBTv HD, DVR, and/or On Demand services are available to your location, please contact one of our offices.

The plans in place have all PBTv subscribers gaining access to IPTV services by 2012, making our Cooperative one of the first providers in the nation to accomplish such a feat.

Your cooperative is committed to providing the latest in telephone, Internet, and television services. We will continue to upgrade our network to make HD, DVR, and On Demand available to as many locations as possible, as quickly as possible. We appreciate your patience as this work continues.

For the vast majority of those locations that do not have access to the services today our cooperative will need to replace the current copper network in your neighborhood and up to your house with a fiber optic network. As you can imagine, this construction work takes time. Here are our current construction plans:

2010 CONSTRUCTION SEASON

Laporte, Deer River, Squaw Lake/Inger/Wirt exchanges will see fiber optic network replacement with IPTV services available by the summer of 2011.

2011 CONSTRUCTION SEASON

Solway, Puposky and Turtle River exchanges will see fiber optic network replacement with IPTV services available by the summer of 2012.

It is important to note there are many factors involved with construction that are beyond our control. Every effort will be made to complete the construction as planned but we cannot guarantee that these plans won't be altered or delayed.

IDA BROOKS: FRS YOUTH TOUR WINNER



Paul Bunyan Telephone has selected Ida Brooks as the winner of the cooperative's 2010 Youth Tour Essay Contest. She will attend the 2009 Youth Tour in Washington, D.C. from June 5-9, with all expenses paid by Paul Bunyan Telephone. Ida is currently a junior at Bemidji High School.

The trip features a comprehensive overview of the telecommunications industry, including careers in telecom, the critical role telecommunications plays in rural America, and how legislative and regulatory decisions affect the industry. The tour allows youth to meet with members of Congress who represent rural constituents. They also participate in educational sessions about the Federal Communications Commission (FCC). Students visit some of the nation's most historic sites, including the Vietnam, Korean and World War II memorials, the Supreme Court, the Smithsonian Museums, Arlington National Cemetery and the Lincoln and Jefferson memorials.

"We hope that by providing our youth with telecommunications services comparable to those found in urban areas, as well as exposing them to cultural and educational opportunities, such as the FRS Youth Tour, our youth will remain in and become active members in their rural communities," said Brian Bissonette, Paul Bunyan Telephone Marketing Supervisor.
