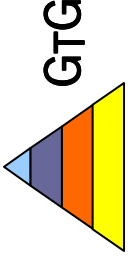


Native American Tribal Housing Training

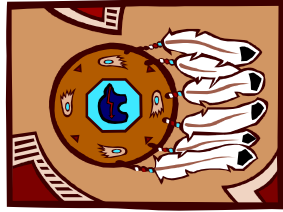
